SUMMARY: The document below is the fine of 12 June and 6 October 1579 by which clear title to 40 acres of salt-marsh in Rainham, Wennington and Aveley in Essex passed from Oxford to William Ayloffe and his son and heir, William, for £16. According to the 16th Earl's indenture of 2 June 1562, Oxford's uncle, Robert Vere, held a life estate in this property, with reversion to Oxford and his heirs (see C 54/626 and WARD 8/13). Since Robert Vere did not die until 1598, it would appear that an agreement was reached between Oxford and his uncle for the sale of these lands. See also CP 25/2/131/1674/21ELIZITRIN, Item 12 for a fine between Robert Vere and William Ayloffe involving the manors of Wennington and Kennington.

This is the final agreement made in the court of the Lady Queen at Westminster three weeks after Trinity in the year of the reigns of Elizabeth, by the grace of God Queen of England, France & Ireland, Defender of the Faith, etc. from the Conquest the twenty-first [=6 July 1579], before James Dyer, Robert Monson, Thomas Meade & Francis Wyndham, justices, and afterwards on the octave of Michaelmas in the abovesaid year of the reigns of the same Queen Elizabeth [=6 October 1579] there granted and recorded before the same justices & others faithful to the Lady Queen then there present, between William Ayloffe, one of the justices of the Lady Queen assigned for the pleas to be holden before herself, the Queen, & William Ayloffe, gentleman, son & heir apparent of the same William, querents, and Edward, Earl of Oxenford, deforciant, of forty acres of salt-marsh with the appurtenances in Rainham, Wennington & Aveley alias Alvethley;

Whereof a plea of covenant was summoned between them in the same court, namely that the foresaid Earl has acknowledged the foresaid tenements with the appurtenances to be the right of himself, William Ayloffe the son, as those which the same William & William Ayloffe, the father, have of the gift of the foresaid Earl, and he has remised & quit-claimed them from himself & his heirs to the foresaid William & William & the heirs of the same William, the son, forever;

And besides the same Earl has granted for himself & his heirs that they will warrant to the foresaid William & William & the heirs of the same William, the son, the foresaid tenements with the appurtenances against the foresaid Earl & his heirs forever;

And for this acknowledgement, remission, quit-claim, warrant, fine & agreement the same William & William have given to the foresaid Earl sixteen pounds sterling.
