

SUMMARY: The document below is an entry in the diary of Henry Machyn describing Oxford's arrival in London on 3 September 1562 after the funeral in Essex of his father, the 16th Earl, who had died on 3 August. It is taken from Nichols, John Gough., ed., *The Diary of Henry Machyn, Citizen and Merchant-Taylor of London* (London: Camden Society, 1848), p. 291.

The 3 day of September came riding out of Essex from the funeral of the Earl of Oxford, his father, the young Earl of Oxford, with 7 score horse, all in black, through London and Cheap and Ludgate, and so to Temple Bar, and so to (blank), between the 5 and 6 of the clock at afternoon.
