

SUMMARY: The excerpt below is taken from the Exchequer Pipe Roll for 1600-01. It indicates that Oxford is listed on the subsidy roll as owing £20, but that the amount has been paid in Essex. A similar situation obtains with respect to Lady St. John and Lady Wentworth.

LM: Essex

Edward, Earl of Oxenford, owes £20 assessed & taxed on him with respect to the first entire subsidy of four subsidies granted by the lords to the Lady Elizabeth now Queen in the 43rd year [=1600/1] of her reign, as is contained in the account of Arthur Manwaring, gentleman, cofferer of the said first subsidy of the four subsidies aforesaid by the roll. By the roll of the accounts of the subsidy, but he answers in the roll following in the item 'Essex'.

Katherine, Lady St. John, owes £12 with respect to the same subsidy, as is contained there. But she answers in the roll following in the item 'Northampton'.

Susan, Countess of Kent, £4 with respect to the same subsidy, as is contained there.

Anne, Lady Wentworth owes £10 with respect to the same subsidy there. But she answers in the roll following in the item 'Oxford'.

Anne, Lady Hunsdon, £10 with respect to the same subsidy there.
