

SUMMARY: The document below likely dates from late 1562 or early 1563, and lists 103 knights' fees belonging to the 16th Earl of Oxford at his death. A knight's fee was a military tenure by which land was held from a lord in return for military service. In the feudal period, the military obligation was real, but by the 16th Earl's time, tenants were rarely called upon to come armed into the field to fight for their lord. The total value of the fees listed for Essex is £3 19s 2d, for Suffolk 17s 8d, for Cambridge 10s 8d, for Hertford 4s, for Norfolk nothing, and for Buckingham 10s 4d, for a total of £6 1s 10d. As indicated in the document, nothing at all was paid for 49 of the 103 fees.

The entries indicate the connection of certain manors and families to the Earls of Oxford.

William Brooke, Lord Cobham, who held the manor of Radwinter in Essex by a knight's fee, was a close friend of Lord Burghley, Oxford's father-in-law.

The Thomas Roydon who held a knight's fee in Ramsey in Essex appears to have been Thomas Roydon (1545-1565), who had various connections to Oxford's Golding relatives. See:

Sir John Wentworth (d.1567), who held lands in Gosfield by half a knight's fee and a manor in Walter Belchamp by a knight's fee, was named an executor of the 16th Earl of Oxford's will.

Richard Tyrrell (d.1566), who held half a knight's fee in Ashdon, left a bequest to Oxford's stepfather, Charles Tyrrell, in his will. See TNA PROB 11/48/637.

The entry for Little Birch is of interest because no tenant is named, although the lands and tenements are said to be 'of William Tendring'. For the descent of these lands, see the summary to the will of Alice Golding, TNA PROB 11/70/187.

George Tyrrell (d.1571) who held lands and tenements in Leckhamstead was the son of Humphrey Tyrrell (d.1549) of Ockendon and Thornton and his wife Jane Ingleton, the granddaughter of Henry VII's tax-gatherer, Sir Richard Empson.
